

1 review of the true outcomes of such projects and the cumulative impacts of a multitude of
2 such projects; and

3 WHEREAS, an in-depth review of the overall and long-term benefits, risks, and
4 hazards of these projects and an independent analysis of current projects that have
5 observable wetland habitat deterioration is necessary to determine whether assimilation
6 projects meet the program goal of benefitting wetlands.

7 THEREFORE, the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana requests
8 the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment to study wetland assimilation
9 projects and to report its findings to the House of Representatives prior to the convening of
10 the 2025 Regular Session.
