 buyer may request a homeowner's association, property owner's association,
 condominium association, or any other planned community association with copies
 of documents governing the property to be purchased, including but not limited to
- the following:

- (1) Building restrictions or restrictive covenants and all amendments.
- (2) Acts creating or establishing a condominium regime or other planned community and all amendments.
 - (3) Articles of incorporation, articles of organization, bylaws, operating agreements and all amendments governing the homeowner's association, property owner's association, condominium association or other planned community association.
 - (4) Rules established by any association that affect the property.
 - B. A buyer may request a copy of any of the documents described in Subsection A which are recorded in the conveyance or mortgage records from the person providing title closing or title settlement services.
 - C. Any person providing a document pursuant to this Section shall not be liable under this Chapter for any error, inaccuracy, or omission in a document provided.
 - D. Prior to, or concurrent with the delivery of the requested documents, the buyer making the request pursuant to this Section shall pay all costs incurred by the person obtaining and providing the requested copies and a reasonable service fee.
- E. Failure to request or receive these documents shall not be cause to extend or terminate the purchase agreement."
