3 WHEREAS, Jeffery L. Mumphrey is a longtime resident of Plaquemine, Louisiana;  
4 he honorably served as a combat engineer in the United States Army from 1987 until 1995;  
5 while serving, he completed combat engineer and nuclear, biological, and chemical Military  
6 Occupational Specialty training; and

7 WHEREAS, Jeffery attended Southeastern Louisiana University from 1993 until  
8 1998 and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in accounting; after graduating, he accepted  
9 the role of solid waste director for Iberville Parish and served in this capacity until 2001; and

10 WHEREAS, Jeffery has served as an employee of the state of Louisiana since 2001;  
11 over the past twenty-three years, he has worked for the office of planning and budget, the  
12 Louisiana Workforce Commission, the Louisiana Community and Technical College  
13 System, Baton Rouge Community College, and the state Department of Education; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Mumphrey has proven to be a dependable, well-organized, and  
15 proactive state employee; he has served under five administrations producing nineteen  
16 executive budgets and five agency-specific budget requests, and he retires as a State Budget  
17 Management Analyst 4 with the office of planning and budget; and

18 WHEREAS, Jeffery L. Mumphrey is most deserving of the highest recognition for  
19 his many professional achievements and for his sincere dedication to the state of Louisiana.

20 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
