## SENATE BILL NO. 184

## AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 14:108.1(E), relative to offenses affecting law enforcement; to provide relative to the crime of aggravated flight from an officer; to increase the penalties for aggravated flight from an officer; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: Section 1. R.S. 14:108.1(E) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: §108.1. Flight from an officer; aggravated flight from an officer

## E.(1) Whoever Except as provided in Paragraph (2) of this Subsection,

 whoever commits aggravated flight from an officer shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not more than five ten years and may be fined not more than two thousand dollars.(2)(a) Whoever commits the crime of aggravated flight from an officer that results in serious bodily injury shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not more than ten fifteen years and may be fined not more than two thousand dollars.
