12 On page 1, line 18, after "Interior" change the period "." to a comma "," and insert "including
13 the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and other relevant preservation
14 best practices."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 2, delete lines 3 through 9 and at the beginning of line 10, change "(4)" to "(2)"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 2, at the beginning of line 14, change "(5)" to "(3)"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 8

20 On page 2, at the end of line 16, insert "This shall include the recommendation of the local
21 historic district landmark commission and other preservation experts with expertise
22 regarding the building or structure and the work being undertaken."

23 AMENDMENT NO. 9

24 On page 2, delete lines 17 through 20 and insert the following:

25 "(4) Following the public hearing, and after review of all comments, the state
26 agency, parish, or municipality undertaking the work, the local historic district
27 commission, or a legislator representing the legislative district in which the property
28 is located may request the opinion of the state historic preservation office on whether
29 the proposed work is appropriate to the historic building.

1 (5) The state agency, parish, or municipality undertaking the work shall
2 consider the opinion of the state historic preservation office prior to beginning any
3 such work.

4 (6)The provisions of this Section do not apply to interior work, routine
5 maintenance, the repair or replacement of a historic feature with the same material
6 or new material that matches the historic material in type, design, dimension, texture,
7 detailing, and appearance, emergency repairs, or work required for the public safety
8 because of an unsafe or dangerous condition."
