## Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Makes a technical change.

2. Provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall not become effective if House Bill No. 315 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature is enacted.

## **Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

<u>Present law</u> (C.C. Art. 3462) provides that prescription is interrupted when an action is commenced in a court of competent jurisdiction and venue.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains present law but removes the requirement of proper venue.

Present law (C.C.P. Art. 863(F)) provides for the imposition of sanctions.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that sanctions shall not be imposed with respect to an original petition that is filed within 60 days of an applicable prescriptive date and then transferred to a court of proper venue.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall not become effective if House Bill No. 315 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature is enacted and becomes law.
