  - (T) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$7,347,006 from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund to the Water Sector Fund.
  - (U) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$3,500,000 from the Louisiana Transparency Fund to the State General Fund (Direct).
  - (V) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$100,000 from the State General Fund (Direct) to the Louisiana Military Family Assistance Fund.
  - (W) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct) to the Dyslexia Fund contingent upon the Act that originated as Senate Bill No. 440 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature becoming law.
  - (X) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$1,000,000 from the State General Fund (Direct) to the Postsecondary Inclusive Education Fund.
  - (Y) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$5,008,881 from the Events Incentive Fund to the Major Events Incentive Fund contingent upon the Act that originated as Senate Bill No. 341 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature becoming law.
  - (Z) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the state treasurer is authorized and directed to deposit into the Overcollections Fund from the revenues in the state general fund an amount equal to the amount of the State General Fund (Direct) for each line item appropriation in the Act that originated as House Bill No. 782 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature that has a State General Fund (Direct) appropriation that is vetoed by the governor other than pursuant to his authority under Article IV, Section 5(G)(2) of the Constitution of Louisiana and that is not overridden by the legislature.
  - Section 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the state treasurer is authorized and directed to deposit into the Overcollections Fund from the revenues in the state general fund an amount equal to the amount of the State General Fund (Direct), for each line item in the Act that originated as House Bill No. 1 of the 2024 Regular Session of the Legislature

- that has a State General Fund (Direct) appropriation that is vetoed by the governor other than
- 2 pursuant to his authority under Article IV, Section 5(G)(2) of the Constitution of Louisiana
- and that is not overridden by the legislature."
