9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. $17:4002.3(2)(b)$ and the introductory paragraph of $4002.5(A)$, $(A)(1)$
11	and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
12	§4002.3. Definitions
13	As used in this Part, the following terms have the following meanings unless
14	the context clearly indicates otherwise:

16	(2) "Eligible funded student" means any student who resides in Louisiana and
17	meets the following criteria:

19	(b) Has obtained approval from the local school superintendent or other Has
20	consulted with the person designated by the governing authority of the school that
21	he attends to enroll in a course pursuant to this Part and has written permission
22	from a parent or legal guardian. Pursuant to R.S. 17:4002.5, the student shall
23	not be permitted to enroll in a course that conflicts with any of the following:
24	(i) A determination made by the student's school counselor that the
25	course is not to be academically appropriate considering the student's chosen
26	major or graduation pathway.
27	(ii) The department's published student high school planning resources.

This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2025; if vetoed by the governor 18 19 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day 20 following such approval by the legislature or July 1, 2025, whichever is later.
