2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1968, 1969(A)(introductory paragraph), and 2191(B)(1),
3	relative to insurance matters; to provide relative to hearing notices and violations;
4	to provide for electronic or physical delivery of notices; and to provide for related
5	matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 22:1968, 1969(A)(introductory paragraph), and 2191(B)(1) are
8	hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§1968. Notice of hearing
10	<u>A.</u> Whenever If the commissioner shall have has reason to believe that any
11	person has been engaged or is engaging in this state in any unfair trade practice as
12	defined in this Code, whether or not defined in this Part, the commissioner shall issue
13	a notice of wrongful conduct to that person in accordance and compliance with R.S.
14	49:977.3 describing the unfair trade practice and citing the law which is deemed by
15	the commissioner to be violated.
16	B. The commissioner may promulgate and adopt rules in accordance with
17	the Administrative Procedure Act to provide means of electronic delivery of the
18	notice required in this Section.
19	§1969. Violations; penalties
20	A. If, after receiving the person's answer or response or if no answer or
21	response is received within twenty days of receipt of mailing, faxing, or <u>electronic</u>
22	or physical delivery of the notice, the commissioner shall determine that the person
23	charged has engaged in an unfair method of competition or an unfair or deceptive act

9	B.(1) Any demand for a hearing shall be filed by the aggrieved party with
10	the commissioner within thirty days after mailing of notice of the act or order to the
11	aggrieved party's last known address or within thirty days after the electronic or
12	physical delivery of notice of the act or order to the aggrieved party. The demand
13	for hearing shall specify in what respects the person is aggrieved and the grounds
14	upon which relief should be granted at the hearing. The aggrieved person shall
15	reference the particular sections of the statutes and rules involved, shall provide a
16	short and plain statement of matters asserted for review, and shall attach a copy of
17	any order or decision of the commissioner for review.
