EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The proposed changes renaming the chapter to "Louisiana Public Charter School Law", updating the intent and purpose of public charter schools, and adding the definition of autonomy are technical in nature, and not expected to result in an increase in state or local governmental expenditures.
