AN ACT
To amend and reenact R.S. 17:170(E), relative to discrimination based on vaccination status;
to prohibit teachers and school employees and administrators from discriminating
between students based on such status; and to provide for related matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 17:170(E) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
§170. Immunization of persons entering schools, kindergartens, colleges,
proprietary or vocational schools, and day care centers for the first time;
immunization of persons entering sixth grade; electronic transmission of
immunization compliance reports
* * *
E.(1) No person seeking to enter any school or facility enumerated in
Subsection A of this Section shall be required to comply with the provisions of this
Section if the student or his parent or guardian submits either a written statement
from a physician stating that the procedure is contraindicated for medical reasons,
or a written dissent from the student or his parent or guardian is presented.
(2) No teacher or school employee or administrator shall distinguish between
students based on whether a student has or has not received vaccines from the
schedule provided for in this Section. Actions prohibited by this Paragraph include
but are not limited to discrimination based on a student's vaccination status in any
of the following acts:
(a) Determination of eligibility for athletics or other extracurricular activity.
