FIRE PROTECT/FIREMEN: Provides for the financial security of surviving spouses and dependent children of deceased firemen in certain circumstances

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Require a firefighter covered by <u>proposed law</u> to be a La. resident in order for his survivors to receive the benefit provided by <u>present law</u>.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for payment of \$250,000 to the surviving spouse, child, or other beneficiary of a fireman who suffers death as a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of the performance of his official duties or arising out of any activity in his capacity as a fireman in the protection of life and property. Specifies the paid and volunteer firemen to whom <u>present law</u> is applicable.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the applicability of <u>present law</u> to include any firefighter who is a La. resident and is employed or under the control of one of the following federal agencies if the injury that resulted in the death occurred in La.:

- (1) Dept. of Defense.
- (2) Dept. of Veterans Affairs.
- (3) Dept. of Agriculture.
- (4) Dept. of the Interior.
- (5) Federal Emergency Management Administration.

Proposed law applies retroactively to Aug. 1, 2023.

(Amends R.S. 40:1665(B))
