| 8 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: |
| 9 | Section 1. R.S. 26:494 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: |
| 10 | §494. Sale of beverages of high alcoholic content in violation of local ordinance |
| 11 | \underline{A} . No person shall sell any beverages of high alcoholic content in violation |
| 12 | of any lawful ordinance or regulation adopted by authority of this Part by any parish |
| 13 | or municipality. |
| 14 | B. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A of this Section, in the |
| 15 | town of Winnsboro, a restaurant establishment whose average monthly revenue from |
| 16 | the sale of food and nonalcoholic beverages equals or exceeds eighty percent may |
| 17 | sell beverages of high alcoholic content until 11:00 p.m. each day of operation. |
