"Art. 978. Motion to expunge record of arrest and conviction of a felony offense
 A. Except as provided in Paragraph B of this Article, a person may file a
 motion to expunge his record of arrest and conviction of a felony offense if any of
 the following apply:

* 16 (2) More than ten years have elapsed since the person completed any 17 18 sentence, deferred adjudication, or period of probation or parole based on the felony 19 conviction, and the person has not been convicted of any other criminal offense during the ten-year period, for a period of at least ten years preceding the motion 20 21 and has no criminal charge pending against him. The motion filed pursuant to this 22 Subparagraph shall include a certification obtained from the district attorney which 23 verifies that, to his knowledge, the applicant has no convictions during the ten-year 24 period and no pending charges under a bill of information or indictment. Prior to 25 filing the motion, the applicant shall obtain a certificate from the district attorney verifying that the applicant has no convictions during the ten years 26 preceding the date of the certificate and that the applicant has no pending 27 28 charges under a bill of information or indictment. The motion for expungement 29 shall include the original certificate and such certificate shall be filed no later than thirty days following the date of the certificate. 30
