Amendments proposed by Senator Kleinpeter to Engrossed House Bill No. 467 by Representative Coates

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Amendments Nos. 2 through 8 proposed by the Senate Committee on Agriculture,
3 Forestry, Aquaculture, and Rural Development and adopted by the Senate on May 22, 2024.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the end of line 2, after "3:1391(27)"change "and" to a comma ","

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 3, after "1394(A)(14)" delete the remainder of the line and insert a comma
8 "," and insert "1398.1, and 1399(D),"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, delete lines 4 through 11 and insert the following:

11 "relative to the sale of raw milk; to provide for commercial feeds; to provide for
12 definitions; to provide for labeling and inspection; to provide for testing and records; to
13 authorize the commissioner of agriculture to suspend the sale, distribution, or movement on
14 raw milk under certain circumstances; and to provide for related matters."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 1, line 14, after "3:1391(27)" change "and" to a comma "," and after "1394(A)(14)
17 insert a comma "," and insert "1398.1, and 1399(D)"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 3, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:

20 "(c) The commission by regulation may adopt, unless it determines that they
21 are inconsistent with the provisions of this Part or are not appropriate to the
22 conditions that exist in this state, the labeling requirements adopted by the
23 Association of American Feed Control Officials and published in the official
24 publication of that organization."

25 AMENDMENT NO. 7

26 On page 3, delete lines 6 through 28 and insert the following:

27 "§1398.1. Testing and records of raw milk
28 A. Raw milk testing for salmonella shall be done once per month by an
29 accredited laboratory. A producer of raw milk shall provide test results to the
30 commission or a customer, upon request.
31 B. Test results shall be kept by the farmer or producer of raw milk for at least
32 two years from testing.
33 §1399. Detained commercial feeds; withdrawal from distribution; condemnation and
34 confiscation; stop order
35 * * *
36 D. The commissioner may temporarily suspend the sale, distribution, or
37 movement of any raw milk from a producer when the raw milk causes an outbreak
38 of a contagious or infectious disease that poses an immediate threat to animal or

1 public health. For the purposes of this Part, the Senate and House committees on
2 agriculture, forestry, aquaculture, and rural development may conduct oversight
3 review to override the commissioner's temporary suspension."
