2	To enact R.S. 18:453(D), relative to dual candidacy; to provide for an exception for a
3	senator or representative in the United States Congress for certain offices; and to
4	provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 18:453(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§453. Dual candidacy
8	* * *
9	D. President or vice president of the United States. Notwithstanding the
10	provisions of Subsection A of this Section, a senator or representative in the
11	United States Congress who has been nominated as a candidate for president
12	or vice president of the United States may become a candidate in a primary or
13	general election for either office in addition to the office he holds that is set to
14	be decided at the same election.
15	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
16	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
17	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
18	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
19	effective on the day following such approval.
