11	C. An applicant for an initial license shall provide, at a minimum, the
12	following:

14	(4)(a) A current audited balance sheet of the school prepared by an
15	independent, certified public accountant within six months prior to the date of the
16	initial application for licensure.

18	§3140.4. Licenses; minimum standards; duration
19	A. No applicant shall be issued a license pursuant to this Chapter until the
20	board has first determined that the school substantially complies with the following:
21	(1) The school's instructors have the following qualifications:
22	* * *
23	(b) In a technical or occupational course, an instructor shall possess, at a
24	minimum, a bona fide high school diploma or its equivalent; a certificate, diploma,
25	license, other degree, or documented evidence of on-the-job training in the area
26	taught; and a minimum of four three years of documented occupational experience
27	in the area taught.
