2 To urge and request the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to encourage and assist local school districts to enter into cooperative endeavor agreements for the 3 cooperative purchasing of products and services in order to save valuable education 4 5 dollars. WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14 of the Constitution of Louisiana provides that 6 7 "(f)or a public purpose, the state and its political subdivisions or political corporations may 8 engage in cooperative endeavors with each other, with the United States or its agencies, or 9 with any public or private association, corporation, or individual"; and 10 WHEREAS, cooperative endeavor agreements for cooperative purchasing are used 11 to simplify the procurement process for smaller public agencies to allow them to purchase through existing contracts negotiated by larger public agencies in order to reap savings and 12 13 increase efficiencies; and 14 WHEREAS, by encouraging one or more smaller school districts to enter into cooperative endeavor agreements for cooperative purchasing with a larger school district that 15 16 has an existing contract that has already gone through a competitive solicitation, evaluation process, and been awarded to a supplier, the smaller school districts can receive the same 17 18 favorable discounts and savings that the larger school district has received; and
