AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 18:423(I), 1302(2), 1313(B) and (E), and 1313.1(B) and (E) and
3	to enact R.S. 18:1309.1(E) and 1373(D), relative to the meetings of the parish board
4	of election supervisors; to provide for notice of meetings; to provide for the
5	preparation, verification, tabulation, and counting of absentee by mail and early
6	voting ballots; to provide for the preparation, verification, tabulation, and counting
7	process without a majority of parish board of election supervisors present; to provide
8	for the selection of parish board commissioners to provide assistance; to provide for
9	the authorization of the commissioner of elections; to prohibit the recording or
10	broadcasting of the preparation, verification, tabulation, and counting process; to
11	prohibit the recording or broadcasting of the preparation, testing, inspection, sealing,
12	and locking of voting machines; and to provide for related matters.
13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
14	Section 1. R.S. 18:423(I), 1302(2), 1313(B) and (E), and 1313.1(B) and (E) are
15	hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 18:1309.1(E) and 1373(D) are hereby enacted to
16	read as follows:
17	§423. Parish boards of election supervisors
18	* * *
19	I. Meetings. Each parish board of election supervisors shall conduct its
20	business in the presence of a quorum. All members of the board must be given
21	actual notice of all board meetings no later than twenty-four hours, exclusive of
22	Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, before each meeting.

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1	§1302.	Definitions
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As used in this Chapter, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, th	ıe
following terms shall have the meanings hereafter ascribed to each:	

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(2) "Board" means the parish board of election supervisors of each parish. If parish board commissioners are utilized by the parish board of election supervisors to count and tabulate absentee by mail and early voting ballots, the term "board" for the purposes of R.S. 18:1306, 1311, 1312, 1313, 1313.1, 1315, and 1316 shall also mean the parish board commissioners providing assistance.

§1309.1. Preparation of machines for early voting; examination by candidate or his representative; sealing machines

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E. The preparation, testing, inspecting, sealing, and locking of the machines shall not be video, audio, or tape recorded, filmed, or broadcast live.

§1313. Tabulation and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots

B.(1) The parish board of election supervisors shall be responsible for the preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of all absentee by mail and early voting ballots in the parish. The board may utilize parish board commissioners to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots in the parish. If the board determines that parish board commissioners are necessary to prepare, verify, count and tabulate the absentee by mail and early voting ballots, it shall select parish board commissioners in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 18:1314. If a majority of the members of the board are not present to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots and no parish board commissioners were previously selected, the members present may select a sufficient number of parish board commissioners on election day to assist in the counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots.

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(2) If an insufficient number of parish board commissioners was selected				
pursuant to R.S. 18:1314 to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots, the				
board, through the registrar of voters, shall request approval from the commissioner				
of elections to select a sufficient number of parish board commissioners on election				
day to assist in the counting of the ballots.

E.(1) Candidates, their representatives, and qualified electors may be present during the preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots. If the counting and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots begin prior to the closing of the polls, the board shall give notice reasonably calculated to inform any person who wants to be present during the preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation that no person will be allowed to leave or to communicate with any other person outside, until such time as the polls are closed, nor shall any person who is present during the preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots possess a cellular telephone or electronic communication or recording device.

(2) The preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots shall not be video, audio, or tape recorded, filmed, or broadcast live.

§1313.1. Preparation, verification, tabulation, and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots

B.(1) The parish board of election supervisors shall be responsible for the preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of all absentee by mail and early voting ballots in the parish. The board may utilize parish board commissioners to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots in the parish. If the board determines that parish board commissioners are necessary for the preparation and verification process to count and tabulate the absentee by mail and early voting ballots before the election and to count and tabulate the absentee by mail and early

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voting ballots on election day, it shall select parish board commissioners in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 18:1314.

(2) If less than a majority but at least two of the members of the board are not present for the preparation and verification process to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots or to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots and no parish board commissioners were previously selected, the members present may and the board cannot locate an alternate designee or appointee, the board shall, through the registrar of voters, so inform the commissioner of elections and request approval from the commissioner of elections for the appointment of a parish board commissioner to serve as a board member. The board shall receive approval of the commissioner of elections before proceeding with the preparation and verification process without a majority present.

(3) If an insufficient number of parish board commissioners was previously selected for the preparation and verification process or to count the absentee by mail and early voting ballots, the board, through the registrar of voters, may request approval from the commissioner of election to select a sufficient number of parish board commissioners three days before the election or on election day, as applicable, to assist in the preparation and verification process for the tabulation and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots and the tabulation and counting of the ballots.

E.(1) Candidates, their representatives, and qualified electors may be present during the preparation and verification process for the counting and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots before the election and the counting and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots on election day. If the counting and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots begins prior to the closing of the polls on election day, the board shall give notice reasonably calculated to inform any person who wants to be present during the counting and tabulation that no person will be allowed to leave or to communicate with any other person outside, until such time as the polls are closed, nor shall any person who is

1 present during the counting and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting 2 ballots on election day possess a cellular telephone or electronic communication or 3 recording device. 4 (2) The preparation, verification, counting, and tabulation of absentee by mail and early voting ballots shall not be video, audio, or tape recorded, filmed, or 5 6 broadcast live. 7 8 §1373.
