## Keyword and oneliner of the instrument as it left the House

STUDENT/ASSESSMENT: Exempts students who attain certain scores on the English and math sections of the ACT from end-of-course testing and allows career diploma students to take WorkKeys or the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery in lieu of the ACT

## **Report adopts Senate amendments to:**

1. Remove proposed law authority to exempt certain students from end-of-course testing.

## **Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:**

1. Allowed all students to take either the ACT, WorkKeys, or the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB).

## Report amends the bill to:

1. Provide that if BESE policy requires students pursuing a diploma other than a career diploma to take the ACT, they may also take WorkKeys and ASVAB and require BESE to develop a system of equivalent scores on such tests for school and district accountability purposes.

## Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

<u>Present law</u> requires high school students pursuing a career diploma to take the ACT and allows them to also take the WorkKeys test. <u>Proposed law</u> allows these students to take WorkKeys or the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) in lieu of the ACT.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if BESE policy requires students pursuing a diploma other than a career diploma to take the ACT, they may also take WorkKeys and ASVAB.

<u>Present law</u>, applicable to career diploma students, requires BESE to develop a system of equivalent scores for the ACT and WorkKeys and to use a student's highest score for purposes of the school and district accountability system. <u>Proposed law</u>, applicable to all students, applies BESE's obligation

to develop such a system to all three of these tests for such purposes.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for <u>proposed law</u> implementation beginning with the 2025-2026 school year. (Amends R.S. 17:183.3(B)(3); Adds R.S. 17:24.4(F)(1)(g))
