2	To amend and reenact R.S. 27:601(B) and 625(G)(7) and to enact R.S. 27:625(G)(8), and
3	Subpart CC of Part II-A of Chapter 1 of Subtitle I of Title 39 of the Louisiana
4	Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 39:100.241, relative to sports
5	wagering; to provide regarding definitions, enforcement, licenses and permits, and
6	wagering; to provide for requirements and regulations; to provide for revenue
7	allocation; to create the Louisiana Equine Promotion and Research Fund; to provide
8	for the transfer, deposit, and use of monies in the fund; to provide for an effective
9	date; and to provide for related matters.
10	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
11	Section 1. R.S. $27:601(B)$ and $625(G)(7)$ are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
12	27:625(G)(8) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	§601. Title and citation; privilege
14	* * *
15	B. Any license, permit, approval, or thing obtained or, issued, or renewed
16	pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter is expressly declared by the legislature to
17	be a pure and absolute revocable privilege and not a right, property or otherwise,
18	under the constitution of the United States or of the state of Louisiana. Further, the
19	legislature declares that no holder of any license or permit acquires any vested
20	interest or right therein or thereunder.

22	§625. State tax; levy

24	G. After complying with the provisions of Subsection D of this Section, each

1	fiscal year the state treasurer shall credit the following amounts to the following
2	funds:

4	(7) Two and one-half percent of the monies collected pursuant to this
5	Section, not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars, shall be credited to the
6	Louisiana Equine Promotion and Research Fund as established by R.S.
7	<u>39:100.241.</u>
8	(8) Any remaining funds shall be available as state general funds.
9	Section 2. Subpart CC of Part II-A of Chapter 1 of Subtitle I of Title 39 of the
10	Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 39:100.241, is hereby enacted to read
11	as follows:
12	SUBPART CC. LOUISIANA EQUINE PROMOTION AND RESEARCH FUND
13	§100.241. Louisiana Equine Promotion and Research Fund
14	A. There is hereby created, as a special fund in the state treasury, the
15	Louisiana Equine Promotion and Research Fund, hereafter referred to in this
16	Section as the "fund".
17	B.(1) After compliance with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B)
18	of the Constitution of Louisiana, the fund shall consist of monies deposited into
19	the fund pursuant to the requirements of R.S. 27:625(G)(7) and any other
20	monies appropriated or transferred by the legislature. The state treasurer shall
21	deposit into the fund all donations, gifts, and grants received by the state for the
22	Louisiana Equine Promotion and Research Program as well as any other
23	monies which may be provided for the program by law.
24	(2) Monies in the fund shall be invested by the treasurer in the same
25	manner as monies in the state general fund, and interest earned on investment
26	of the monies shall be credited to the fund. All unexpended and unencumbered
27	monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund.
28	C. Monies in the fund shall be appropriated to the Department of
29	Agriculture and Forestry for the Louisiana Equine Promotion and Research
30	Program in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 3:2076 and 2077.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
