AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 3:1391(23) through (26) and to enact R.S. 3:1391(27),
3	1394(A)(14), 1398.1, and 1399(D), relative to the sale of raw milk; to provide for
4	commercial feeds; to provide for definitions; to provide for labeling and inspection;
5	to provide for testing and records; to authorize the commissioner of agriculture to
6	suspend the sale, distribution, or movement on raw milk under certain circumstances;
7	and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 3:1391(23) through (26) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
10	3:1391(27), 1394(A)(14), 1398.1, and 1399(D) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
1	§1391. Definitions
12	For the purposes of this Part the following definitions shall apply:

14	(23) "Raw milk" means the lacteal secretion from any species other than
15	humans, that has not been pasteurized in accordance with the processes recognized
16	by the United States Food and Drug Administration.
17	(23) (24) "Registrant" means the person registering a feed with the
18	commission.

15	(a) The express words '	'WARNING: NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION
16	- THIS PRODUCT HAS NO	T BEEN PASTEURIZED AND MAY CONTAIN
17	HARMFUL BACTERIA". T	This statement shall be displayed in a conspicuous
18	manner and shall not be smaller	than the height of the minimum form required by the
19	Federal Fair Packaging and La	beling Act for the net quantity statement in the table
20	below:

22	<u>≤5 in.2</u>	<u>1/16 in.</u>

2	are inconsistent with the provisions of this Part or are not appropriate to the		
3	conditions that exist in this state, the labeling requirements adopted by the		
4	Association of American Feed Control Officials and published in the official		
5	publication of that organization.

7	§1398.1. Testing and records of raw milk		
8	A. Raw milk testing for salmonella shall be done once per month by ar		
9	accredited laboratory. A producer of raw milk shall provide test results to the		
10	commission or a customer, upon request.		
11	B. Test results shall be kept by the farmer or producer of raw milk for at least		
12	two years from testing.		
13	§1399. Detained commercial feeds; withdrawal from distribution; condemnation and		
14	confiscation; stop order		
15	* * *		
16	D. The commissioner may temporarily suspend the sale, distribution, or		
17	movement of any raw milk from a producer when the raw milk causes an outbreak		
18	of a contagious or infectious disease that poses an immediate threat to animal or		
19	public health. For the purposes of this Part, the Senate and House committees on		
20	agriculture, forestry, aquaculture, and rural development may conduct oversight		
21	review to override the commissioner's temporary suspension.
