Miller

New law provides that a filiation action pursuant to existing law shall be a civil action brought in an ordinary proceeding under Book II of the C.C.P., and may be instituted separately or cumulated in a succession proceeding. New law further provides that the mere commencement of a succession proceeding under Book VI of the C.C.P. shall not constitute the instituting of a filiation action for purposes of existing law.

New law provides that the provisions of new law shall be interpretive, procedural, and remedial.

Effective August 1, 2024.
