Existing law provides for \$250,000 in survivor benefits to the spouse or other legal survivor of a fireman or law enforcement officer in certain circumstances.

New law retains existing law.

Prior law provided that if a fireman or law enforcement officer has a dependent child or children, the sum of \$25,000 would be paid for each dependent child to the duly appointed and qualified tutor or legal representative of each child.

New law increases the amount to be paid for each dependent child from \$25,000 to \$50,000.

Effective August 1, 2024.
