Existing law provides for powers and duties of the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists (board).

New law creates a new licensed psychological associate license issued by the board.

<u>New law</u> provides for qualifications and requirements for a person to receive the license.

<u>New law</u> establishes fees for application and licensure to be collected by the board.

<u>New law</u> provides certain discretion to the board in issuing the license.

<u>New law</u> provides for the scope of practice and limitations for licensed psychological associates.

<u>New law</u> provides for procedures for license renewal, denial, revocation, and suspension.

<u>New law</u> provides for privileged communications to a licensed psychological associate.
