**ACT 479 (SB 159)**

New law creates the Preserving Lawful Utilization of Services for Veterans Act that provides for protection for veterans against person's receiving compensation for providing certain services to veterans.

New law provides for certain circumstances that an individual or business is prohibited from providing services to veterans for compensation.

New law provides for limitations on the amount of compensation received for providing the services.

New law requires the person providing services to veterans to provide a written disclosure containing information regarding veteran's services.

New law provides that violations of new law constitute an unfair, false, misleading, or deceptive act or practice in the conduct of trade or commerce under the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law.

New law requires entities that assist veterans with initial disability claims to provide certain information to the Dept. of Veterans Affairs.

Effective June 3, 2024.
