<u>Existing law</u> provides for the issuance of a driver's license and special designation on a driver's license and special identification card.

<u>New law</u> adds a special designation of "seizure disorder" to driver's license and special identification card.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes an applicant for a driver's license or special identification card to request a designation.

<u>New law</u> adds "seizure disorder" to the list of designations that may be requested on driver's license or special identification card.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the applicant for a driver's license or renewal of a driver's license to provide a sworn statement from a qualified licensed medical professional verifying the medical condition and prohibits any additional fee for the designation.

<u>New law</u> adds the designation of seizure disorder to the list of those who must provide a sworn statement from a qualified licensed medical professional verifying the medical condition and prohibits any additional fee for the designation.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of <u>new and existing law.</u>

Effective August 1, 2024.
