ACT 484 (SB 438) 2024 Regular Session Miller

<u>Existing law</u> provides for the appointment of members and residency requirements for levee commissioners.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further requires that each appointment meet all of the following requirements:

- (1) Reside in this state for the preceding two years.
- (2) Reside in the levee district for the preceding year.
- (3) Be a qualified voter of one of the parishes included in the district.
- (4) Have or possess the equivalent of a high school diploma. This requirement shall only have prospective application and shall only apply to new appointments nor shall it apply to reappointment of existing members.
- (5) Reside in the district while serving as a member of the board.

<u>New law</u> adds a prospective educational requirement to new appointees and not to reappointment of existing members of levee commissions.

Effective August 1, 2024.
