Miller

Existing law provides for the appointment of members and residency requirements for levee commissioners.

New law retains existing law and further requires that each appointment meet all of the following requirements:

- (1) Reside in this state for the preceding two years.
- (2) Reside in the levee district for the preceding year.
- (3) Be a qualified voter of one of the parishes included in the district.
- (4) Have or possess the equivalent of a high school diploma. This requirement shall only have prospective application and shall only apply to new appointments nor shall it apply to reappointment of existing members.
- (5) Reside in the district while serving as a member of the board.

New law adds a prospective educational requirement to new appointees and not to reappointment of existing members of levee commissions.

Effective August 1, 2024.
