Existing law provides for the crime of nonconsensual disclosure of a private image and provides for elements of the offense, penalties, and definitions.

Prior law provided that one of the elements of nonconsensual disclosure of a private image was when the person who disclosed the image obtained it under circumstances in which a reasonable person would know or understand that the image was to remain private.

New law changes this prior law element to include obtaining the image through unauthorized access.

Existing law defines the terms "criminal justice agency", "disclosure", "image", and "intimate parts".

New law provides a definition for "unauthorized access".

Effective August 1, 2024.
