Existing law provides for the creation of parish communications districts which provide 911 services and which are funded by charges on telephone service.

Existing law provides that a governing authority of any communications district may levy a commercial mobile radio service (CMRS) telephone service charge not to exceed \$1.25/month per wireless CMRS connection.

<u>New law</u> increases the maximum CMRS telephone service charge in Terrebonne Parish to \$1.85/month per wireless CMRS connection.

Effective August 1, 2024.
