Muscarello

Prior law required clerks of district courts to collect and disburse a fee and submit information required by the supreme court when a suit had been filed in district court for damages arising from an offense or quasi offense.

Prior law provided that information received by the judicial administrator pursuant to prior law was not subject to subpoena.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 8, 2024).
