## Mack

<u>New law</u> requires a political subdivision that is established by statute and that at any point in the then-current or immediately prior year had total outstanding judgments in excess of \$7.5 million to include in its audit, compiled financial statement, or other required reporting to the legislative auditor a complete list of all outstanding judgments, beginning in 2025.

<u>New law</u> requires such listing to include the following:

- (1) The caption and number of the matter.
- (2) The court in which the matter was filed.
- (3) The date of the judgment or the date the agreement was entered.
- (4) The amount of the original judgment or agreement.

<u>New law</u> requires the legislative auditor to compile the reports into a single biennial report and to submit his report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget and the governor by December 1st.

<u>New law</u> provides that the reporting requirements in <u>new law</u> terminate on January 1, 2031.

Effective upon lapse of time for gubernatorial action (June 25, 2024).
