Existing law requires a parish board of election supervisors to publish the location of the polling places in the parish at least once in the official journal of the parish during the third week before a primary election.

Existing law also requires the locations to be published on the website of the secretary of state.

Prior law authorized parish election officials to publish polling locations on their websites.

<u>New law</u> instead requires a parish registrar or clerk of court who maintains a website to publish polling locations on his website, arranged by precinct, beginning 30 days prior to an election.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the secretary of state to include on his website instructions on how a voter may subscribe to electronic notifications of polling place location changes.

<u>Prior law</u> required parish election officials to include on their websites instructions on how a voter could subscribe to receive electronic notifications of polling place location changes.

<u>New law</u> removes <u>prior law</u>.

Effective August 1, 2024.
