<u>Existing law</u> provides that it is the intent of the legislature to promote rapid development of a statewide electric vehicle charging network. <u>Existing law</u> additionally urges the Public Service Commission to explore excluding certain persons or corporations from the definition of public utility.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and urges the Public Service Commission to explore excluding from the definition of public utility persons or corporations that furnish electricity to charge marine vessels and vessel-mounted or on-shore power points that are primarily used for marine vessels.

Effective August 1, 2024.
