ACT 9 (HB 6)

2024 Third Extraordinary Session

Beaulieu

Existing constitution (Const. Art. XIII, §1(A)(1)) requires that each joint resolution proposing a constitutional amendment specify the statewide election at which the proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the state's electors for ratification. Provides that special elections for submitting proposed constitutional amendments may be authorized by law.

New law provides that a special statewide election shall be held on Sat., March 29, 2025, for the purpose of submitting to the state's electors proposed constitutional amendments contained in joint resolutions concurred in during the 2024 3rd E.S. Provides that new law shall be void and of no effect if no proposed constitutional amendment that specifies the special statewide election on March 29, 2025, as the statewide election at which the proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the electors is concurred in.

New law provides that the election shall be held in compliance with applicable provisions of existing law (La. Election Code).

Effective upon signature of governor (December 4, 2024).
