2 To amend and reenact R.S. 11:3383, relative to New Orleans Firefighters' Pension and 3 Relief Fund; to provide for benefits for retired firefighters and surviving spouses; to 4 provide relative to employee contributions; and to provide for related matters. 5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published 6 as provided by Article III, Section 13 and Article X, Section 7 29(C) of the Constitution of Louisiana. 8 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 9 Section 1. R.S. 11:3383 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 10 §3383. Minimum pension for firefighters on retired list 11 Any other provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding 12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, each firefighter on the 13 retired list of the fire department and each surviving spouse of a member of the fire 14 department shall receive a pension of not less than twelve hundred dollars per month. 15 B. The contributions now required by law to be paid into the fund by 16 firefighters on the active list shall not be increased by reason of any provision of this 17 Section.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the minimum benefit for each member and surviving spouse of the New Orleans Firefighters' Pension and Relief Fund is \$1,200 per month.

<u>Present law</u> provides that contributions paid to the fund by firefighters are not to be increased.

Proposed law makes technical corrections.
