**Abstract:** Reduces the allowable percentage of light transmission through any sun blocking film or device on the front side windows of a motor vehicle.

<u>Present law</u> requires that a sun screening device used in conjunction with automotive safety glazing materials have a light transmission of at least 40% on front side windows, 25% on side windows behind the driver, and at least 12% on the rearmost windows. Further prohibits sun screening devices that have a luminous reflectance of more than 20%. Additionally, provides certain exemptions to <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by changing the percentage of light transmission allowable for sun screening devices, including window tint, on the front side windows of a motor vehicle <u>from</u> 40% to 25%.
