Abstract: Provides for the membership, powers, and duties of the La. State Bd. of Medical Examiners.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the La. State Bd. of Medical Examiners (LSBME) shall have 10 voting members who are all appointed by the governor and subject to Senate confirmation.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the membership of the LSBME from 10 to 11 voting members by adding one member from a list submitted by the La. Academy of Physician Assistants.

Present law provides grounds for removal from the LSBME.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds to those grounds that the governor may remove and reappoint members at the beginning of a governor's term.

<u>Present law</u> provides that LSBME members are appointed for four-year terms beginning on July 1st of the year in which the appointment is made. <u>Present law</u> prohibits LSBME members from serving more than three consecutive terms.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> by providing that no member shall serve more than two consecutive terms.

Present law provides for mandatory and discretionary powers and duties of the LSBME.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds to the mandatory powers and duties of the LSBME that the LSBME shall select officers and adopt rules and bylaws necessary for the efficient operation of the LSBME. <u>Proposed law</u> further adds that the LSBME is required to adopt rules in accordance with the APA to carry out the LSBME's duties, powers, and functions as provided in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides that it is within the LSBME's discretion to select officers and adopt rules and bylaws necessary for the operation of the LSBME. <u>Present law</u> provides that it is also within the LSBME's discretion to adopt rules, regulations, and standards necessary to carry out the LSBME's duties, powers, and functions in <u>present law</u>.

Proposed law makes these powers and duties mandatory instead of discretionary.
