Abstract: Prohibits election officials and boards of election supervisors from entering into a consent decree or other legal agreement providing election procedures in conflict with the Election Code without authorization by the legislature through a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the elected members of each house of the legislature.

<u>Present constitution</u> (Const. Art. XI, § 1) provides that the legislature shall adopt an election code which shall provide for permanent registration of voters and for the conduct of all elections.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no state, parish, or local election official or the state board of election supervisors or a parish board of election supervisors shall enter into a consent decree or other legal agreement that prescribes election procedures that conflict with procedures prescribed by <u>present law</u> (Election Code) except as otherwise provided by <u>present law</u> or as authorized by adoption of a concurrent resolution approved by a majority of the elected members of each house of the legislature.
