## DIGEST 2025 Regular Session

Luneau

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 44:3.3) provides that nothing in the public records law shall require the disclosure of commercially sensitive information in the custody or control of a public power authority.

<u>Present law provides that a "public power authority" means a political subdivision of the state created</u> by the governing authority of a municipality pursuant to <u>present law</u>, for the purpose of the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation, or management of a public power project or improvement.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but further provides that a "public power authority" shall also mean a utility division or department organized as an enterprise proprietary fund for the city of Alexandria.

Effective August 1, 2025.
