Abstract: Expands the application of the expedited enforcement program by increasing the penalties to which it applies.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the enforcement and authority of the secretary to engage in a civil process for litigating the violations of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the assessment of civil penalties for enforcement actions provided under <u>present law</u> of minor to moderate violations that do not exceed \$3,000 per violation or an aggregate total of \$5,000 per violator.

<u>Proposed law modifies present law</u> by increasing the penalties for minor to moderate violations <u>from</u> \$3,000 <u>to</u> \$5,000 per violation and <u>from</u> \$5,000 <u>to</u> \$10,000 in the aggregate per violator.
