3	to state supplemental pay for fire protection officers; to authorize state supplemental

5	submission of the proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide for related

7	Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members
8	elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of
9	Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to
10	amend Article X, Section 10(A)(1)(b) of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows:
11	§10. Rules; Investigations; Wages and Hours
12	Section 10.(A) Rules. (1) Powers.

14	(b) Nothing herein shall prevent the legislature from supplementing the
15	uniform pay plans for sworn, commissioned law enforcement officers employed by

**Abstract:** Provides for state supplemental pay to fire protection officers employed by an airport authority

<u>Present constitution</u> authorizes the legislature to provide state supplemental pay by law to sworn, commissioned law enforcement officers employed by the state or its political subdivisions and for fire protection officers employed by a port authority.

<u>Proposed constitution</u> retains <u>present constitution</u> and authorizes the legislature to provide state supplemental pay by law to fire protection officers employed by an airport authority.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 3, 2026.
