WATER/SEWER OPERATORS OR NO IMPACT See Note  
Provides relative to receivership of water or wastewater companies

Proposed law establishes conditions under which a court may appoint a receiver for a water company or wastewater private company to continue operations. Proposed law provides that a receiver may be appointed if the company has been abandoned, fails or refuses to comply with administrative orders issued by the Louisiana Department of Health or the Department of Environmental Quality, is in financial distress after a Public Service Commission (PSC) audit, or under other circumstances PSC may identify when a receivership is needed. Finally, proposed law provides when a receiver must execute a bond, outlines the receiver's duty to follow court orders until discharged, and defines the conditions under which the court may dissolve the receivership.


*Note: PSC regulates approximately 25 water systems and 35 wastewater systems. Public water systems are subject to similar receivership conditions under RS 30:2075.*
