**Abstract:** Provides an exception to certain locations where a person cannot carry a concealed handgun.

Present law provides for locations where a person cannot bring a concealed handgun.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, but amends the provision relative to a parade or demonstration for which a permit is issued by a governmental entity to clarify that a person or permittee is prohibited from carrying a concealed handgun at a parade or demonstration when he is an active participant in such parade or demonstration.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not apply to a bystander or spectator who attends a parade or demonstration for which a permit is issued by a governmental entity.
