AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 32:1(1), relative to the definition of "authorized emergency 3 vehicle"; to provide for the addition of authorized vehicles used for coroner 4 investigations to the definition of "authorized emergency vehicle"; and to provide for 5 related matters. 6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 7 Section 1. R.S. 32:1(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 8 §1. Definitions 9 When used in this Chapter, the following terms have the following meanings 10 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 11 (1) "Authorized emergency vehicle" means a vehicle of a fire department, 12 a vehicle of the department's weights and standards police force, a police vehicle, a 13 private vehicle, a privately owned vehicle belonging to members of an organized 14 volunteer fire department or fire district when so designated or authorized by the fire 15 chief of that fire department or fire district, an industrial-owned vehicle assigned to 16 members of a fire department or fire district when so designated or authorized by the 17 fire chief of that fire department or fire district, a vehicle parked or stopped by 18 elevator repair or construction personnel while responding to an elevator emergency, 19 such as ambulances and emergency medical response vehicles certified by the

Louisiana Department of Health that are operated by certified ambulance services,

authorized vehicles used for coroner investigations, and emergency vehicles of
municipal departments or public service corporations as are designated or authorized
by the secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development or by the
chief of police of any incorporated municipality. For purposes of this Section,
elevator repair shall be limited to those elevators that move people.

Abstract: Adds authorized vehicles used for coroner investigations to the definition of "authorized emergency vehicle".

Present law defines "authorized emergency vehicle" as a vehicle of a fire dept., a vehicle of the dept.'s weights and standards police force, a police vehicle, a private vehicle, a privately owned vehicle belonging to members of an organized volunteer fire dept. or fire district when so designated or authorized by the fire chief of that fire dept. or fire district, an industrial-owned vehicle assigned to members of a fire dept. or fire district when so designated or authorized by the fire chief of that fire dept. or fire district, a vehicle parked or stopped by elevator repair or construction personnel while responding to an elevator emergency, such as ambulances and emergency medical response vehicles certified by the La. Dept. of Health that are operated by certified ambulance services, and emergency vehicles of municipal depts. or public service corporations as are designated or authorized by the secretary of the Dept. of Transportation and Development or by the chief of police of any incorporated municipality.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds authorized vehicles used for coroner investigations to the definition of "authorized emergency vehicle".
