Abstract: Provides for record retention of audit trail information in the state prescription monitoring program.

<u>Present law</u> requires persons authorized to dispense or distribute controlled dangerous substances or drugs monitored by the Prescription Monitoring Program to submit certain information to the La. Board of Pharmacy (board).

<u>Present law</u> requires the board to establish standards by rulemaking for the retention, archiving, and destruction of prescription monitoring information.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires the board to establish rulemaking standards for the retention, archiving, and destruction of audit trail information.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further states that <u>present</u> and <u>proposed law</u> shall not be construed to modify the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 44:411).

<u>Proposed law</u> requires all agencies to keep all records in accordance with <u>present law</u> after approval and requires approval before destroying records.

(Amends R.S. 40:1006(G); Adds R.S. 40:1006(H))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Require the retention of all records and approval before the destruction of any records.
