Subject: Fiscal and Economic Impact Statements greater than \$200,000

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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

OR SEE FISC NOTE GF EX

Provides for fiscal and economic impact statements under the Administrative Procedure Act. (8/1/25)

Proposed law requires that if the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) determines a rule has a fiscal or economic impact greater than \$200,000 per year or more than \$1 M over five years, the rule shall not take effect unless the appropriate House and Senate subject matter committee approves the rule.

Current law requires agencies to provide a written notice of their emergency action no later than five days after the adoption of an emergency rule. Proposed law requires the notice to contain an estimated financial and economic impact statement by the LFO; provides that if the fiscal or economic impact is greater than \$200,000 per year or more than \$1 M over five years:

(1) the rule shall not take effect unless the appropriate House and Senate subject matter committee approves the rule and

(2) the governor must publish a statement explaining the necessity of the emergency rule.
