A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Wednesday, April 30, 2025, as LMA Municipal Day at the state capitol. 3 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Municipal Association (LMA) was founded in 1926 as 4 a nonprofit 501(c)4 organization serving as a unified voice for Louisiana's municipal 5 governments; and 6 WHEREAS, the LMA is a statewide member organization that advocates on behalf 7 of three hundred five members, consisting of one hundred twenty-seven villages, one 8 hundred twelve towns, sixty-four cities, and two parishes; and 9 WHEREAS, the LMA wholly owns two subsidiaries: Risk Management, Inc. (RMI), 10 and Louisiana Municipal Advisory and Technical Services Bureau (LaMATS); LMA 11 provides administrative management services for Louisiana Municipal Gas Authority, 12 Louisiana Recreation and Park Association, Louisiana City Attorneys Association, Louisiana 13 Municipal Clerks Association, and Building Officials Association of Louisiana; LMA has 14 multiple affiliate and advisory partners including the Louisiana Community Development 15 Authority, the Louisiana Municipal Association of Unemployment Compensation, the 16 Louisiana Association of Tax Administrators, the Louisiana Association of Municipal 17 Secretaries and Assistants, Municipal Employees Retirement System of Louisiana, the 18 Louisiana Fire Chiefs Association, the Louisiana Airport Managers and Associates, the 19 Louisiana Conference of Mayors, the Louisiana Municipal Black Caucus of Local Elected Officials, and the Louisiana Association of Chiefs of Police; and 20

1	WHEREAS, the mission of the LMA is to educate and empower local governments
2	to serve the citizens of Louisiana efficiently and effectively and to advocate on behalf of
3	municipal governments; and
4	WHEREAS, the LMA provides numerous programs and services to its member
5	municipalities, such as conferences, training, webinars, legislative advocacy, and
6	information technology assistance; RMI-managed funds and liability programs including
7	liability indemnification, worker's compensation, and unemployment compensation; and
8	LaMATS-sponsored programs such as procurement services, delinquent property tax
9	collection, insurance premium tax collection, occupational license tax collection, and
10	consulting; and
11	WHEREAS, the LMA continues to promote local governments by shaping
12	legislation, providing education on municipal issues, and exchanging ideas and experiences
13	among elected officials throughout the state; the LMA has partnered with the Police Jury
14	Association of Louisiana to establish LITACorp, which provides technical assistance to
15	political subdivisions with competitive federal grant opportunities and a matching-funds
16	program specifically for local government entities in rural and economically distressed
17	communities; and
18	WHEREAS, the LMA executive committee members include the Honorable Rick
19	Allen, mayor of Leesville, president; the Honorable Ray Bourque, mayor of Broussard, first
20	vice president; the Honorable Michael Chauffe, mayor of Grosse Tete, immediate past
21	president; the Honorable Charles E. Robichaux, mayor of Rayne, District G vice president;
22	and the Honorable Barney Arceneaux, executive director; and
23	WHEREAS, the LMA is celebrating ninety-nine years of advocacy, education, and
24	public service; and
25	WHEREAS, on Wednesday, April 30, 2025, the LMA hosts its annual LMA
26	Municipal Day and legislative advocacy day at the Louisiana state capitol, celebrating all
27	three hundred and five municipalities and local government officials and their employees
28	for dedication to public service in our state.
