| 9 | B.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the term "drug |
| 10 | paraphernalia" shall not include rapid fentanyl test strips (FTS) or any testing |

| 12 | substance contains fentanyl or its analogues. any controlled dangerous substance |
| 13 | or chemical compound that can cause physical harm or death. Testing |
| 14 | equipment may include, but is not limited to, the following: |
| 15 | (a) Rapid fentanyl test strips. |
| 16 | (b) Portable drug testing kits certified by the FDA or the National |

(c) Laboratory-based analytical devices, such as gas 1 2 chromatograph-mass spectrometers used by laboratories accredited by the 3 American Society of Crime Laboratory Directors. 4 (2) No device listed in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall be used to facilitate either the manufacture or distribution of controlled substances. 5 6 7 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 11 effective on the day following such approval.

Present law defines "drug paraphernalia" and exempts rapid fentanyl test strips or any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains fentanyl or its analogues from the definition.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the definition to include any testing equipment or devices solely used, intended for use, or designed to determine whether a substance contains any controlled dangerous substance or chemical compound that can cause physical harm or death.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary C to the original bill

1. Make a technical change from "chemical or compound" to "chemical compound".

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

Provide examples of testing equipment that will be exempt from proposed 1. law definition of "drug paraphernalia".

2. Provide that an exempted device will be deemed drug paraphernalia if it is used to facilitate either the manufacture or distribution of controlled dangerous substances.
